Heels of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland for
certain good causes and considerations on thereto moving as
also in further consideration of one dollar current money
to me in hand paid have released from Slavery liberated
manumitted and set free and by these presents do hereby
release from Slavery liberated manumitted and set free my
negro man named James Henson being of the age of
forty years and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood
and maintenance and him the said negro man named
James Henson I do declare to be ~~free~~ henceforth free
manumitted and discharged from all manner of
servitude or service to me my executors or administrators
