To all whom it may concern be it known that we William
Glover and Mary Glover of the City of Annapolis in Anne Annall
County and State of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations
we hereunto moving as also in further consideration of the sum
of forty dollars current money to us in hand paid have released
from slavery liberated manumitted and set free and by these
presents do hereby release from slavery liberate manumit and
set free our negro man named Daniel Troy being of the age of
fifty years and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood
and maintenance and him the said negro man named
Daniel Troy we do declare to be henceforth free manumitted
and discharged from all manner of servitude or service to
us our executors or administrators forever. In Testimony
whereof we hereunto set our hands and affix our seals this
eleventh day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and twenty six
