To all whom it may Concern be it Known that I Henry B  
Harwood of the City of Annapolis in the State of Maryland for  
diverse good Causes and Considerations me therewith moving as  
also in further Consideration of Ten dollars current money to  
me in hand paid have released from Slavery liberated  
manumitted and set free and by these presents do hereby  
release from Slavery liberate manumit and set free my  
negro man named John Wells formerly the property of  
Mr. Elizabeth Leys being about the age of thirty three  
years and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood  
and maintenance and him the said John Wells named  
as above. I do declare to be free manumitted and  
(discharged)
