and maintenance. which said before mentioned negroes I do hereby
declare to be henceforth free, unammitted and discharged from
all manner of servitudes to me my executors or assigns forever
given the testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hands and
affixed my seal this fourteenth day of March eighteen hundred
and twenty six
