

liberated manumitted and set free and by these presents doth hereby release from slavery liberate manumit and set free my negro woman named Eliza who was bequeathed by last will and testament of Robert Warfield senior late of said County to me until she arrived at the age of twenty five years and then to be free and who is at this time of the age of twenty two years I likewise release from slavery liberate manumit and set free her infant child named George who is under one year old the said woman being able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance and her the said negro woman named Eliza and her infant son named George I do declare to be hereafter free manumitted and discharged from all manner of servitude or service to me my executors or administrators forever In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the twenty first day of November in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and twenty five
