Barolton of the said County in this deed of
manumission named and acknowledged to be
his act and deed. James Hunter.

To all whom it may concern Be it known
that I Elizabeth Chiles of Anne Arundel County
and State of Maryland for divers good causes
and considerations mentioned moving also
in further consideration of five dollars current
money to me and have paid do from and after
the twenty ninth day of March eighteen hundred
and thirty four release from the said liberte
manumit and set free and do by these presents
from and after the time aforesaid release from
slavery liberte manumit and set free my negro
girl named Maria she being eight years of
age the twenty ninth day of March last, and
her increase to be free when they respectively
arrive to the age of twenty five years of age
and her the said negro girl named Maria
and her increase I do declare to be from and
after the time aforesaid to be free and unincumbered
and discharged from all manner of servitude or
service,
