To all whom it may concern be it known that I Timothy
 Johnson of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland for
 aivers good Causes and Considerations me therunto moving as
 also in further Consideration of two dollars current money to me
 in hand paid have released from slavery liberated manumitted
 and set free and by these presents do hereby release from slavery
 liberate manumitted and set free the following negroes to-wit
 Negro Lloyd. Negro Louisa Negro Jimmy Negro Cornelias
 and Negro Adeline to be free as hereinafter mentioned that
 is to say Negro Lloyd at the age of twenty one years. Negro
 Cornelias at the age of twenty one years. Negro Jimmy Louisa
 & Adeline at the age of eighteen ~~years~~ years. and as all the
 said negroes above named I do declare to be free at the
 several ages as above mentioned manumitted and
 discharged from all manner of servitude or service then
 & their issue to me my executors or administrators forever
 In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and affixed my seal this fifteenth day of June in the year
 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty six
