 Maryland for divers good Causes and Considerations me
 therunto moving as also in further Consideration of one
 dollar current money to me in hand paid have released
 from Slavery liberated (manumitted) and set free and
 by these presents do hereby release from Slavery liberate
 manumit and set free my negro girl named Casandra
 at the age of twenty five years she being five years old
 the eight day of last December of a healthy Constitution
 sound in mind and body and to presents appearances
 will be capable by labour to procure herself sufficient
 food and raiment with other requisites necessaries of
 life. In testimony whereof I have herunto set my
 hand and affixed my seal this 20th day of January 1827
