Know all men by these presents that I Burgard
 Sheriff of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland
 for divers good causes and considerations now thereunto
 moving have manumitted liberated set free & discharged
 from Slavery & do hereby manumit liberate set free &
 discharge from Slavery my negro woman Nelly now
 aged about twenty five years. The said manumission
 to take effect when the said Nelly shall arrive at the
 age of thirty five years which period for greater certainty
 I now fix & declare to be the twenty fifth day of January
 Anno Domini eighteen hundred & thirty seven at which
 time the said Nelly is to be free from all claims of myself
 my executors administrators and assigns. And whereas
 the said Nelly is intermarried with a certain James
 Sparrow and it is my wish & intention that any children
 which may be born of the said Nelly shall be free on
 certain conditions I do hereby manumit liberate set
 free & discharge from Slavery and every child
 that may be born of the said Nelly prior to the said
 twenty fifth day of January Anno Domini eighteen
 hundred and thirty seven provided the same James
 (Sparrow)
