

To all whom it may concern be it known that I Richard Weems of Arno Annapolis County and State of Maryland for divers good causes contherunto moving and for the further Consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars to me in hand paid have released from Slavery liberated manumitted and set free and by these presents do hereby release manumit and set free my negro man named Stephen Fisher aged forty four years and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance and him the said Negro Stephen Fisher I do declare hereafter to be free manumitted and discharged from all manner of servitude or service to me my heirs executors and administrators forever In witness whereof I have set my hand and seal this 28th day of February 1827
