 Allen to be at free liberty when he shall arrive at the age  
 of twenty one years. Negro Lewis Negro Beale Louis  
 Negro Etha and Negro Henry Asbury to be at free  
 liberty when they shall severally arrive at the age of  
 twenty one years hereby acknowledging the above  
 named negroes at the above named time to be discharged  
 from all claims of service and right of property whatsoever  
 from me my heirs executors administrators or assigns  
 As witness my hand and seal this first day of March  
 one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven
