

Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations murtherunto moving do hereby declare free manumission & enfranchise the following negroes to wit negro Perry aged fifteen years to be free at the expiration of six years from the date of these presents negro Sally aged thirteen to be free at the expiration of three years from the date of these presents negro Polly aged eleven at the expiration of five years and negro Rebecca aged seven years at the expiration of nine years from the date of these presents hereby acknowledging the above named negroes with their increase at the expiration of the spaces and term of years above mentioned discharged from all claims of services and right of property whatever from me my heirs executors or administrators In witness whereof I have set my name and affix my seal this tenth day of January one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven Signed Sealed and delivered
