

To all whom it may concern be it known that I John W Lunsdale of Anne Arundee County and State of Maryland for divers good Causes and therunto moving as also the further sum of one dollar to me in hand paid have release from Slavery manumitted and set free and by these presents do hereby release from Slavery manumitted and set free my negro man Simon being of the age of fifty years and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance and him the said negro Simon I do declare to be hereforth free manumitted and discharged from all manner of Servitude to me my heirs executors or administrators forever In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1827
