To all whom it may concern be it known that Lucy
Harwood of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland
for divers good causes and considerations methinks
moving as also in further consideration of five dollars
current money to me in hand paid have released from
Slavery liberated manumitted and set free the following
servants to wit one negro woman named Maria Watkins
and her two children Noble and Joseph are to be free from
the date of this manumission and as all the issue of Maria
Watkins after this date to be free forever. Further declare
that the said servants on this day are manumitted and
discharged from all manner of service to me my executor
or administrators forever. In testimony whereof I have
hereto set my hand and affixed my seal this tenth day
of April one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven
