 Received the 11th day of April 1827

Know all men by these presents that I Rachel Snowden
 of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland for divers
 good causes and considerations me hereunto moving have
 liberated manumitted and set free and by these presents
 do liberate manumit and set free all the following described
 negro slaves now my property and in my possession viz
 Nacee Bacon a negro man aged thirty four. Belle Sanders
 a negro man aged thirty two. Becky a negro woman
 aged forty two. Nancy a negro woman aged thirty four
 Mary Bull a mulatto woman aged twenty seven. Louisa
 Bull a mulatto woman aged twenty two. Patsy Bull
 a mulatto woman aged eighteen years they all being
 capable of labour sufficient to maintain themselves. And
 by the said slaves above named I declare to be hence forth
 free manumitted and discharged from all manner of services
 to me my executors and administrators forever and I do
 further liberate manumit and set free all the following
 described negro slaves now my property and in my
 (possession)
