


This Indenture made this seventeenth day of August  
 eighteen hundred and twenty seven between Elizabeth Hammond  
 of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland of the one part  
 and Peter Barrett of the County and State aforesaid of the  
 other parts (Witnesseth that the said Elizabeth Hammond  
 as well as for the sum of five dollars current money to me in  
 hand paid before the sealing and delivery of these presents  
 and also for and in consideration of the natural love and  
 affection which the said Elizabeth Hammond hath and  
 beareth unto the said Peter Barrett as also for the better  
 maintenance and supporte livelihood and preferment of her  
 the said Peter Barrett hath given and granted unto the said  
 Peter Barrett her son Nicholas Barrett aged about seven  
 years old to serve her the said Peter Barrett until he shall  
 arrive to the years of one and twenty and then to be free forever  
 and the said Elizabeth Hammond do bind myself my  
 executors administrators and assigns forever to defend these  
 presents and testimony whereof I have hereunto affixed  
 my seal this date and year first above writing)

At the foot of the aforesaid deed was thus written to wit  
 State of Maryland Anne Arundel County. On this 17<sup>th</sup> day of August  
 1827 before me one of the justices of the peace in and for the said  
 County appears Elizabeth Hammond and acknowledges  
 the foregoing instrument of writing to be her act and deed  
 according to the true intent and meaning therein and the  
 acts of assembly in such case made and provided
