 Ann Boone of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland
 for divers good causes and considerations as also in further
 consideration of the sum of five dollars current money
 to me in hand paid have released from slavery liberated
 manumitted and set free and by these presents do hereby
 release from slavery liberate manumit and set free my
 negro man named Harry Barnes being of the age of
 thirty eight years capable to work and gain a sufficient
 livelihood and maintenance and him the said negro
 man named Harry Barnes I do declare to be henceforth
 free manumitted and discharged from all manner of
 servitude or service to me my executors or administrators
 forever. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and affixed my seal this twenty eighth day of December
 eighteen hundred & twenty seven
