 by these Presents do hereby release from slavery, Liberate
 Manumitted and set free my negro woman Phebe Deborah
 and one male child Francis She being of the age of
 thirty four years and able to work and of sufficient
 Liveliness and maintenance and her then and negro
 Woman named Phebe Deborah and one male child
 Francis I do declare to be hence forth free manumitted
 and Discharged from all manner of servitude or service
 to me my Executors or Administrators forever in Testimony
 Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed
 my seal this thirty first day of March Eighteen hundred
 and twenty eight
