Negro Timothy I Elizabeth Johnson of Anne Arundel
County in the State of Maryland for divers good
causes and considerations me thereunto moving do
hereby declare free manumission and En franchise the
following Negro boy (the name of Timothy) aged
three years old Let it may to be at free Liberty at the
age of twenty one years and at the expiration of Eighteen
years from May 1827 hereby acknowledge the
above named Negro boy to be free and full liberty
at the age and Term above mentioned discharged
from all claim of service right of property whatsoever
from me my heirs Executors Administrators and assigns
by any person or persons claiming under us or by my
heirs and so also this seventeenth day of January
Eighteen hundred and twenty eight
