 Sophi Moore of Anne Arundel County in the State of
 Maryland for divers good causes and considerations me
 thereunto moving as also in further consideration of one
 dollar current money to me in hand paid have released
 from slavery liberated, manumitted and set free
 and by these presents do hereby release from slavery
 liberate, manumit and set free my negro girl Sarah
 Sarah aged about eight years of age to be free
 when she arrive at the age of sixteen years from
 the date hereof able to work and gain a sufficient
 livelihood and maintenance and the said negro girl
 Sarah and her Increase to be free to her latest generations
 I do declare to be free manumitted and discharged
 from all manner of servitude or service to me my
 Executors or administrators forever. In Testimony whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal
 this twenty seventh day of November in the year of our
 Lord Eighteen hundred and twenty eight.
