and discharged from all service to her or any claiming
under her and to be free and manumitted according to
the act of assembly in such cases made and provided.

To all whom it may concern be it known that I
Samuel Norman of Anne Arundel County and State of
Maryland for divers good causes and considerations,
in moving thereunto as also in further consideration
of five dollars current money to me in hand paid
have released from slavery, liberated, manumitted and
set free and by these presents do manumit and set
free my negro man by the name of Jacob Adams
after he the said Jacob shall have arrived at
the age of thirty five, which will be on the twenty
third day of December in the year of our Lord
Eighteen hundred and thirty nine, and which date
will be eleven years from the date of these presents,
