 and acknowledges the same to be his act and deed
 for the purposes within mentioned and the negroes within
 named to be (when they shall arrive at the respective
 terms specifically stated) manumitted and discharged
 from all services to him or to or to any claiming under
 him and to be free and manumitted according to the
 act of assembly in such cases made and provided.

To all whom it may concern be it known that I
 Anne Stocker of Anne Arundel County and State of
 Maryland, for divers good causes and considerations me
 thereunto moving also in further consideration of one dollar
 current money to me in hand paid, have released from
 slavery, liberated, manumitted and set free, and by
 these presents do hereby release from slavery, liberate,
 manumit and set free, my negro man named Bob
 or Robert, being at the age of thirty years, and able
 to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance
 and here the said negro man named Bob or Robert
 I do declare to be henceforth free, manumitted and
 discharged from all manner of servitude or service to
 me, my executors or administrators forever. In testimony
