To all whom it may concern, be it known that I Frederick Selby, for divers good causes and considerations me thereunto moving, also in further consideration of the sum of five dollars to me in hand paid, have released from slavery liberated manumitted & set free, & by these presents do hereby release from slavery, liberate, manumit & set free my negro girl named Catharine Cox being of the age of twenty four years, and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance, and her the said negro girl named Catharine Cox. I do hereby declare to be hence forth free manumitted and discharged from all manner of servitude
