 form of the act of Assembly in such cases made and

To all whom it may concern Best known that
 I Joseph Phelps of Anne Arundel County in the City
 of Annapolis and State of Maryland for divers good
 causes and considerations met thence moving as also
 in further consideration of five shillings current
 money to me in hand paid have released from
 Slavery my negro woman Henry Hall being about
 the age of twenty years and able to get her living
 have liberated manumitted and set free and by
 these presents do release from Slavery liberate
 manumitted and set free the said negro woman
 Henry Hall from and after the fifteenth of March
 Eighteen hundred and thirty two. I do declare the
 said negro woman Henry Hall to be free
 manumitted and discharged from all manner of
 servitude or service to me my heirs Executors or
 administrators forever after the expiration of the
 term above mentioned. In Testimony whereof I have
 hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this
 sixth day of August in the year of our Lord one
 thousand,
