 Henry H Harwood and Samuel Maynard Esquires
 all of the City of Annapolis and State aforesaid jointly
 and severally my attorney and attorneys with full power
 to appear for me and in my name and as my act and
 deed to acknowledge in due form of Law this Instrument
 before some judge or justice according to the Laws of
 the State of Maryland and to deliver possession of the
 aforesaid slaves and servants as above bargained and sold
 or mentioned or intended so to be unto the said Lewis with
 as fully and effectually as myself would do if personally
 present and I the said John Guyer do hereby ratify and
 confirm the said acknowledgements and delivery so to be made
 and done by the said Thomas Harris, Henry H Harwood
 and Samuel Maynard Esquires or either of them as aforesaid
