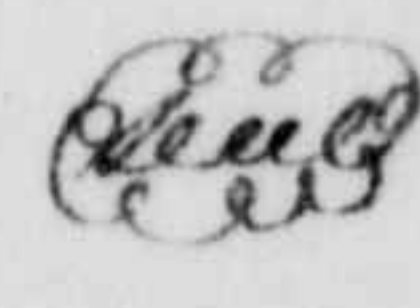

To all whom it may concern be it known that I Charles Munroe of Ann Arundel County and State of Maryland for divers good causes me thereunto moving, and for the further consideration of one dollar to me in hand paid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have released from slavery liberated manumitted and set free and by these presents do liberate manumit and set free my negro Girl Rachel aged six years on the following terms to-wit: when she arrives at the age of thirty years and her increase the males to be free at the age of thirty years and the females at the age of twenty years and their increase forever, and I do declare the said negro Girl Rachel to be discharged from all service or
