Catharine Hutton of Anne Arundel County, in the State
of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations me
thereunto moving as also in further consideration of five
dollars current money to me in hand paid I have
released from slavery, liberated, manumitted and set
free and by these presents do hereby release from slavery
liberate manumit and set free my negro woman Julet
being of the age of twenty three years and able to work
and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance and
her the said negro woman named Julet I do declare to
be henceforth free manumitted and discharged from all
manner of servitude or service to me my executors or
administrators and all the increase of the said negro
Julet that may be born hereafter to be free to there
latest generations In testimony whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty fifth
day of January in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred
and thirty.
