

This Indenture witnesseth that I Aaron Jones of
Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland for
and in consideration of the sum of one Cent to me in
hand paid at and before the enrolling and delivery of
these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
have released from slavery manumitted and set free
and by these presents do release from slavery manumit
and set free my wife Sally and her two boys and daughter
names William, Francis and Susan they being under
forty five years of age, of a healthy constitution, sound
in mind and body and capable by labour to procure
themselves sufficient food and raiment with other
requisite necessities of life. In testimony whereof I
