To all whom it may concern, be it known that I
Robert Warfield of Anne Arundel County in the State
of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations
me therunto moving as also in further consideration of one
dollar current money, to me in hand paid, have released
from Slavery, liberated, manumitted and set free and
by these presents do hereby release from Slavery, liberate
manumit and set free my mulatto man named William
being of the age of twenty three years and able to work
and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance
and him the said mulatto man named William I
do declare to be henceforth free, manumitted and
discharged from all manner of servitude or service to me
my Executors or administrators forever. In testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my
seal this Sixth day of April in the year of our Lord
Eighteen hundred and thirty.
