

her time of servitude expires they shall be free, and I do hereby for myself my heirs executors and administrators the above named negroes release and discharge from all service from and after the above named termes forever.



To all whom it may concern be it known that I Nathaniel Thibicium of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland for divers good causes me therunto moving and also for the further sum of five dollars to me in hand paid have released from slavery liberated, manumitted and set free and by these presents do hereby release from slavery manumit and set free my negro woman named Mary aged about forty one years and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and her child aged about

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
