(To all whom it may concern, be it known that I David Clark of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations me thereunto moving as also in further consideration of seventy five dollars current money to me in hand paid have released from slavery liberated, manumitted and set free and by these presents do hereby release from slavery, liberate, manumit and set free my Negro man Lot Johnson being of the age forty four years and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance and
