



State of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations
me thereunto moving as also in further consideration of one
hundred dollars current money to me in hand paid have
released from slavery, liberate, manumit and set free my
negros to wit a woman named Precila aged forty two
years being able to work and gain a sufficient lively hood
and maintainance one girl named Kenney being of the
age of four years and one boy named James of the age of
two years and therewith the said negros as named above I
do declare to be henceforth free manumit and
discharged from all manner of servitude or service to me
my executors or administrators forever. In testimony whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this
Eighteenth day of June 1830.

manumit and discharged from all services to him or to
any claiming under him to be free and manumit
according
