and set free and do hereby manumit, liberate and set free
from and after the the thirtieth day of September one
thousand eight hundred and thirty my negro man named
Gustavus (Dorsey) being within the age allotted by law and
able to earn a livelihood and I do hereby for myself my
heirs, executors and administrators the said negro man
Gustavus (Dorsey) release and discharge from all service
whatever from that time forever in witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and seal this the 30th day of September
one thousand eight hundred and thirty.
