

free on the first day of January Eighteen hundred and thirty six, negro woman Ann aged nineteen years to be free on the first day of January Eighteen hundred and thirty seven, negro boy Jack aged sixteen years to be free on the first day of January Eighteen hundred and forty and negro child Cardine aged one year to be free on the first day of January Eighteen and fifty five and I do also hereby declare that the issue or increase of the above described female negroes, should as they hereafter have any at the years or age of Twenty five each shall be free, and I do hereby declare the above described negroes to be discharged from all manner of service to me my heirs Executors or administrators from and after the periods above limited for their respective freedom.
