To whom it may concern be it known that I Sarah E. Murray of the City of Annapolis State of Maryland for divers and good reasons and considerations me thereto moving as also in further consideration of one dollar current money to me in hand paid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have released from slavery, liberated, manumitted and set free and by these presents do hereby release from slavery, liberate, manumit and set free my negro man named David sometimes called David Broxon about forty years of age of a healthy constitution sound in body and mind, and capable by labour to procure to himself sufficient food and raiment with other requisite necessaries of life. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this thirtieth day of December in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and thirty.
