

To whom it may concern be it known that I Sarah E. Murray of the City of Annapolis and State of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations me thereto moving as also in further consideration of one dollar current money to me in hand paid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have released from slavery, liberated, manumitted and set free and by these presents do hereby release from slavery, liberate, manumit and set free my negro woman named *Sary* and her two children one named Susan about sixteen years of age and the other named Anthony about fourteen years of age all of healthy constitutions sound in body and mind and capable by labor to procure to themselves sufficient food and raiment with other requisite necessaries of life. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this thirtieth day of December in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and thirty.
