To all whom it may concern, be it known, that I Thomas Price of Anne Arundel County State of Maryland for divers good causes and Considerations me therunto moving, as also in further Consideration of five dollars current money to me in hand paid, have released from slavery, liberated, manumitted and set free, and by these presents do hereby release, manumit and set free my negro man named Edward Dowel on the first day of December one thousand eight hundred & thirty six, being of the age of twenty nine years and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance
