This Indenture Witnesseth that I Joseph R
Hopkins of the City of Philadelphia in the State of
Pennsylvania for divers good causes and considerations
and humbly moving have released from Slavery
manumitted and set free and by these presents do
release from Slavery manumitted and set free my
negro woman named Kate being of the age of twenty
three years of a healthy constitution sound in mind
and body and capable by labor to procure sufficient
food and raiment with other required necessities
of life Provided that the said Kate shall continue
to serve me as heretofore and in all things demean
herself as a faithful and obedient servant to me
until the first day of October in the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred twenty three.
