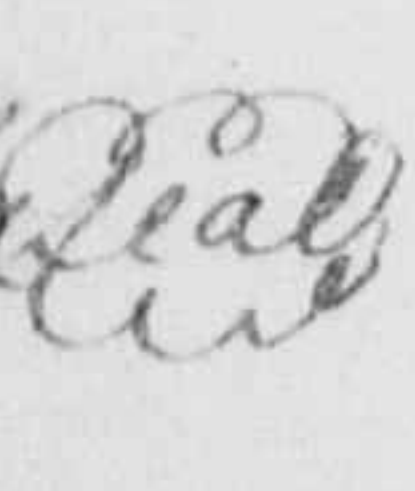


To all whom it may concern, be it known, that I

 paid have released from slavery, liberated, manumitted
 and set free, and by these presents do hereby release
 from slavery, liberate, manumit and set free my negro
 child named Mary Ann daughter of my mulatto
 woman Ann born on the fifteenth day of January
 eighteen hundred and thirty two from and after the
 first day of January eighteen hundred and forty six, and
 her the said negro child named Mary Ann I do
 declare to be free, manumitted and discharged from
 all manner of servitude or service to me my executors
 or administrators forever, from and after the said first
 day of January eighteen hundred and forty six.

In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and affixed my seal this twenty third day of January
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
 and thirty two.

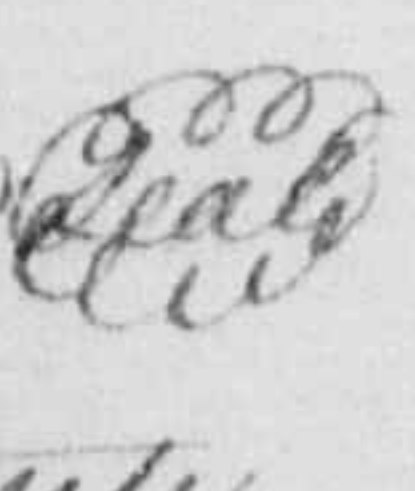
