To all whom it may concern, be it known that I Samuel H Hamilton of Ann. Arundell County and State of Maryland for divers causes me thereunto moving as also for the further sum of Two dollars current money to me in hand paid have released from slavery, liberated, manumitted and set free, and by these presents do hereby liberate, manumit and set free my negro man named Thomas or Thomas Ross so called aged forty four years and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance and him the said negro man Thomas I hereby declare to be free manumitted and discharged from all manner of service or servitude to me my heirs Executors and administrators forever from and after the first day of March next. In witness whereof I have set my hand and seal this Twenty seventh of February, eighteen hundred and thirty two.
