To all whom it may concern, be it known, that I, William Ireland of Ann. Arundel County and State of Maryland as aforesaid, for divers good causes and consideration me thereunto moving, as also in further consideration of Five Dollars current money to me in hand paid, have released from slavery, liberated, manumitted and set free, and by these presents, do hereby release from slavery, liberate, manumit and set free my negro man named Bill or William Sims being of the age of twenty nine years to be free from and after the first day of January Anno Domini one thousand Eight hundred and forty two, and able to work & gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance, and him the said negro
