To all whom it may concern be it known that I Isaac
Doney of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland
for divers good causes and considerations me therunto
moving as also in further consideration of the sum of
one dollar current money to me in hand paid have
released from slavery, liberated, manumitted and
set free and by these presents do hereby release from
slavery, liberate, manumit and set free my negro girl
named Susan being of the age of seventeen years on the
3rd of October next, and I do declare her to be
manumitted and set free from all manner of
servitude or service when she shall arrive to the
full age of twenty one years, which full time will
end on the 3rd day of October 1836, and the said Susan I
