To all whom it may concern that I Sophia Stephens of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland being the sole heir and representative of Solomon Edwards late of Anne Arundel County deceased, for divers good causes me thereunto moving as for the further consideration of the sum of five dollars to me in hand paid have released from slavery liberated manumitted and set free and by these presents do hereby release from slavery manumit and set free my negro woman named Henry Jackson being of the age of twenty one years and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance, and her the said
