

the State of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations me therunto moving as also in further consideration of one dollar current money to me in hand paid have released from slavery: liberated manumitted and set free, and by these presents do hereby release from slavery, liberate, manumit and set free my mulatto man named Charles, being of the age of thirty two years and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance, and him the said mulatto man named Charles I do declare to be henceforth free, manumitted and discharged from all manner of servitude or service to me my Executors or administrators for ever. In testimony whereof I herunto set my hand and affixed my seal this tenth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty two.
