To all whom it may concern, be it known that I William J Goldsborough of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland for divers causes and considerations, me therunto moving as also in further consideration of five dollars current money to me in hand paid have released from slavery liberated manumit and set free my negroes named Hannibal Cooper, Phillis Cooper and Maria Bennet issue of Phillis Cooper. Hannibal being of the age of nineteen to be free at thirty two, Phillis being the age of seventeen to be free at twenty seven and Maria Bennet being eighteen months of age to be free at twenty five years of age and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance and them the said negroes above named, I do declare from and after the above ages to be free, manumitted and discharged from all servitude to me my Executors or administrators for ever. In testimony whereof I have herunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this the seventh day of August eighteen hundred and thirty two.
