Be it known to all persons that I George Barber of the city of Annapolis in Ann Arundell County for divers good causes me thereunto moving and for the further sum of fifty dollars to me in hand paid have liberated, manumitted and set free and by these presents do hereby liberate, manumit and set ~~free~~ my following negroes on the terms herein mentioned to wit Bill Tashie Aged thirty two years to be free in twelve years from the date hereof. Ben Aged nineteen years to be free in twenty years from this date. Bill Rurrel Aged twenty years to be free in twenty four years from the date hereof. John Aged twelve years to be free in twenty eight years from the date hereof. Jacob Aged five years to be free in thirty four years from the
