Jacob Hollingsworth of Anne Arundel County in the State
of Maryland for divers good causes & Considerations me
thinks moving as also a further consideration of the
sum of five dollars current money to me in hand paid
have released from slavery liberated, manumitted &
set free & by these presents do hereby release from
slavery liberate, manumit & set free my negro woman
named Prudence, being about the age of thirty five
years & able to work & gain a sufficient livelihood &
maintenance & her the said negro woman named
Prudence formerly the property of my aunt Ann
Hollingsworth of the City of Baltimore) I do hereby
declare to be henceforth free manumitted & discharged
from all manner of servitude or service to me my
executors or administrators forever. In testimony
whereof, I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my
seal this sixteenth day of February in the year of our
Lord eighteen hundred & thirty two
