To all whom it may concern, be it known
that I Maria Gambrell of Anne Arundel County
in the State of Maryland, for divers good causes
and considerations me thereunto moving, as also in

liberate, manumit and set free, and by these
presents will hereby release from slavery, liberate
manumit and set free at the expiration of three
years from the date of these presents, my negro man
Thomas, being of the age of forty years, and able to
work
