To all to whom it may concern, be it known that
I Henry Maynardier of Anne Arundel County in the
State of Maryland, for divers good causes and
considerations me thereunto moving, have released
from slavery, liberated, manumitted and set free,
and by these presents do hereby release from slavery,
liberate manumit and set free, my negro girl
named Rebecca Roberson, being of the age of nine
years on the first day of September last past, and
able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood
and maintenance, and her the said negro girl
named Rebecca Roberson I do declare to be
henceforth free manumitted and discharged
from all manner of servitude or service to me,
my executors or administrators forever.

In testimony whereof, I have herunto set
my hand and affixed my seal, this 25th day of
September in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and thirty three.
