Whereas I Margaret Mercer of Anne Arundell County Maryland, did on the 12th day of February in the year 1827, execute a deed of Manumission in favour of Negro Kelly Sparrow to take effect on the fifth day of January eighteen hundred and thirty seven, reserving to myself a property in the services of said Negro Kelly until that time, and whereas, it is now my wish and intention to remit the said service due me, and to set her absolutely free from this time. Now know all men by these presents, that I Margaret Mercer, for divers good causes and considerations me thereunto moving, have manumitted, liberated, set free, and discharged, and by these presents do hereby manumit, liberate, set free and discharge from slavery or servitude, the said Negro woman Kelly, now aged about thirty one years, and able to work, and gain a sufficient livelihood & maintenance
